Regardless of the deductible portion of your dues, the total amount of your annual REALTOR® dues are payable on the due date.*

The NAR Board of Directors at its annual meeting on June 5, 2025, approved NAR's 2026 budget which keeps the NAR dues unchanged at \$156/annual and \$45/annual special assessment for the Consumer Ad Campaign. The approved budget also reallocates \$35 of the special assessment for NAR's general operating account. The remaining \$10 will go towards the Consumer Ad Campaign.

*A portion of your Oregon REALTOR® dues includes a \$50 allocation into the *Oregon REALTOR® Political Action Committee (ORPAC). However, you may choose to re-allocate \$50 of your total Oregon Realtor® dues – to either the HOME Foundation or the Issues Mobilization Fund by sending an email message to redirect@oregonrealtors.org and specifying your choice. Any re-direct requests MUST be made within 48 hours of the time dues are paid. Redirect requests received after the 48-hour time frame of payment will not be honored. Please note, ORS 316.102 may provide for a credit against Oregon state taxes of up to \$50 per individual or \$100 per joint return for contribution to political committees, including ORPAC. If you have further questions or concerns, please call 503-362-3645.*

**In 2024, the Oregon Legislature passed campaign finance reform (HB 4024) limiting the amounts that political action committees can contribute to candidates. This new law allows associations such as Oregon REALTORS® to operate a traditional political action committee (PAC) as well as a new type of political action committee called a “Small Donor Political Committee.” Small Donor Political Committees cannot accept contributions in excess of \$250 but are subject to less stringent limits on the amounts they can contribute to candidates. Oregon REALTORS® has established a second political action committee (Oregon REALTORS® Political Action Committee 2, or ORPAC2) that will operate as a Small Donor Political Committee. The \$50 allocation will go to ORPAC2.*

As part of the application process, all brand-new REALTOR® Members who have never belonged to another REALTOR® association are required to complete a REALTOR® Code of Ethics New Member Course, a Fair Housing training and an EMAR Orientation class as a condition of REALTOR® membership.

Dues are not refundable when a member leaves the business, area, or member office.



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
